We/I agree to:

- Inform the school of any concerns that might affect my child's learning or behaviour. I will discuss any concerns directly with the school and not on social media or any other social forum.
- Attend parents' evenings and engage in meetings to discuss my child's progress.
- Support the school when my child receives a detention and accept that this is non-negotiable part of the school's behaviour system
- Ensure my child attends school regularly and on time.
- On a daily basis, check my child's uniform meets the school's requirements and ensure they are fully equipped each day.
- Support the Greenshaw expectations which are as follows: be ready to learn; persevere with learning; be safe and considerate; do as asked first time; show respect to staff, students and the school.
- Support the school policies and procedures regarding punctuality, uniform, equipment, behaviour, mobile phones by helping my child to accept responsibility for their actions, including accepting consequences and not excusing my child from sanctions set.
- Ensure my child completes their homework on time and support them with it where necessary.
- To support the school in upholding our shared value of tolerance and equality of all groups of people no matter our own personal beliefs.
